### *Mono Lake and the Saline Lake Sisterhood: Surviving the Anthropocene*

Mono Lake may be one of the few protected and intact, saline lake ecosystems left on the planet as water diversions and climate change put increasing pressure on our remaining salt lake ecosystems. Bartshé Miller, Mono Lake Committee's Education Director and soon-to-be Eastern Sierra Policy Director, will explore recent bird research, issues, and protection at Mono Lake with a recent snapshot of sister lakes in the West and around the world.

Bartshé Miller has worked for the Mono Lake Committee for most of the twenty five years he has lived in the Mono Basin. An earlier life spent in Chicago, New York City, and Los Angeles has made him a fan of the Public Trust, outdoor education, adventure-gardening, roadkill ecology, and pursuing ephemeral phenomenon around Mono Lake.
